- **A.** Each family promises to raise \$650 throughout the school year, by participating in one or more of the following fundraising events:
  - 1. SCRIP gift cards (see description for details on credit)
  - 2. Purchasing dress down passes at Rock Around the Lot (100% credit)
  - 3. Purchasing Super Raffle tickets (50% credit)
  - 4. Buying and/or selling tickets to the Beefsteak (100% credit)
  - 5. Buying and/or selling tickets to the Tricky Tray (100% credit)
  - 6. Donating cash to the Tricky Tray (100% credit)
  - 7. Registration fees for after school clubs (100% credit)

## ----AND/OR----

**B.** Each family may reduce the amount owed by volunteering at events, **for a maximum of \$150 credit.** 

To earn the \$150 credit, you must volunteer for five event slots, or commit to regularly scheduled lunch duty. A list of eligible events is attached. Sign up sheets with time slots will be available at Welcome Back Reception and Back to School Night.

**C.** If you know ahead of time that you will not participate in fundraising and/or volunteering, you may pay the \$650 obligation, either upfront in full, or in monthly installments

## EVENTS ELIGIBLE FOR CREDIT ON FUNDRAISING PROMISE

The following events are eligible for **\$150 credit** on your Fundraising Obligation: (All of the below are full year commitments)

- Tricky Tray Coordinator organizes and plans all aspects of Tricky Tray
- **Lunch Duty** participates in weekly lunch duty Hours are between 11:30am and 1:30pm (approximately) and duties include selling and serving food and drinks, and
- wiping down tables at the end of the lunch period.
- Super Raffle Coordinator organizes all volunteers and manages all aspects of Super Raffle
- Scrip Coordinator- manages Scrip program and organizes volunteers
- Class Parent class parent description is provided by School Principal

The following events are eligible for **\$75 credit** on your Fundraising Obligation:

- **Talent Show Coordinator** –Plans, organizes and produces the school Talent Show. The show will take place twice- once during the day and once in the evening.
- **Box Top Coordinator** Publicize, collect and submit box tops.

The following events are eligible to **earn up to a \$150 credit** on your Fundraising Obligation. (To earn the\$150 credit, you must participate in five time slots. Only the committees listed below will be considered for the credit. Participation in fewer than five time slots will result in a pro-rated participation credit.)

- 50/50 and Apparel booth at the St. Peter's Parish Carnival; September 21-25, 2016 Volunteer to work one or more 3-hour shift at the parish carnival, selling 50/50 tickets and school apparel. \*\*\*PLEASE NOTE: Only the 50/50 and Apparel booth will count toward your Fundraising Obligation. You will not receive credit for working any other booths.
- Rock Around the Lot; October 12, 2016
  Volunteer to chaperone this fun event in the school parking lot.
- Book Fair; October 30 November 3, 2016 Sign up for one or more 3-hour shift to sell books during school hours.
- 5K Turkey Trot Race; November 19, 2016 Secure sponsorships and provide hands-on help the morning of the race.
- Breakfast with Santa; December 3, 2016
  Help decorate, set up and clean for this fun pancake breakfast with Santa.

#### • Santa's Workshop; December 6 – 8, 2016

Sign up for one or more 3-hour shift, during school hours, to sell small gift items that the students can buy for their friends and families.

### • Beefsteak; January 14, 2017

Volunteer to help set up and host this fun football event.

#### • Tricky Tray; February 9, 2017

This is the school's biggest event and there are many positions available. Volunteer to help with a range of responsibilities-- securing cash and prize donations, selling tickets, decorating, wrapping gift baskets, hosting the night of, and bookkeeping after the event.

#### • Plant Sale; May 9, 2017

Volunteers are needed to help organize and distribute plants at a pick-up site in the school parking lot. Sign up for one or more 3-hour shift, either during school hours or in the early morning or evening. Various time slots are available.

#### SCRIP Sales—ongoing

Volunteer to sell SCRIP gift cards after Masses either once or twice a month, on Sundays after Masses. Volunteers are needed at both St. Peter's Parish and Queen of Peace Parish.
