

HERMAN and FRANK LANGER SCHOLARSHIP

The Langer family lived in the town of River Edge, near St. Peter the Apostle Church and School for many decades. Both men served in the Armed Forces, Herman in the Army and Frank in the Air Force. They were active members of St. Peter Parish, Knights of Columbus, VFW and the community. The brothers felt that service and commitment to the church and community were important and rewarding.

In planning their estates, Herman and Frank decided to establish a Trust which would reward the students and graduates of St. Peter Academy who best exemplified a commitment to St. Peter's and their community. They believed that **Faith**, **Knowledge** and **Service** were the key aspects needed in order to live a meaningful and rewarding life.

The 2018 Herman and Frank Langer Scholarship is again being offered to current students at St. Peter Academy, graduates attending a Catholic high school and graduates of St. Peter Academy attending a four year college. Five scholarships of \$2,000.00 each will be awarded to current students in grades one through eight. Five scholarships of \$5,000.00 each to graduates of St. Peter's Academy attending a Catholic high school, and five scholarships of \$5,000.00 each will be offered to graduates of St. Peter Academy who are graduates of a Catholic high school and are attending a four year college.

This year St. Peter Academy is celebrating a great accomplishment, being recognized as a Blue Ribbon school. In celebration of this accomplishment, requirements for the scholarships are as follows:

Current Students of St. Peter Academy: (Grades 1-7)

- 1) Copies of the student's last 2 report cards.
- 2) 1 letter of recommendation from a special adult in your life.
- 3) A short essay (Grades 4-7), or a drawn picture (Grades 1-3) with this years'

Eighth Grade Students:

Requirements for the scholarships are as follows:

- 1) Copies of the student's last 2 report cards.
- 2) 1 letter of recommendation from a special adult in your life.

Then write a short essay about what you did and why and how you feel about it.

Graduates of St. Peter Academy Attending a Catholic High School:

- 1) A copy of their St. Peter's Academy diploma.
- 2) 2 letters of recommendation from a teacher/staff member of your current school.
- 3) A copy of your last report card.
